



All Saints Parish \$5,000 Trip Voucher Raffle

All Saints Parish needs your help to raise money for our new Multipurpose Facility on St. John's Campus! Thanks to a generous donation from an All Saints Parish family, we are able to offer a \$5,000 travel for a grand vacation of the winners choosing through Dube Travel. Yes! The lucky winner will plan the vacation of their dreams with a credit balance of \$5,000! They will choose the destination and Dube Travel will do the rest! **In addition, this same generous family will also donate a full 2018/2019 school year scholarship plus registration fees to the SJCS student that sells the most tickets during the student ticket sale dates of January 13-February 7, 2018** (sales will continue for the parish until February 12th). The SJCS student that sells the most tickets will also do the honor of drawing the lucky ticket on February 14th and will help us make the call to the winner. All Students and their families are encouraged to participate!

Rules for ticket sales:

1. Student Ticket Sales – January 13-February 7, 2018.
2. Tickets are \$10/each. No more than 10 tickets can be purchased PER HOUSEHOLD. Please remind your buyers!
3. All Tickets will be numbered and need to be signed out by a parent. Each student will be allotted one group of tickets (10 per group). Once all 10 tickets have been sold, a parent can come to the school to sign out another packet of tickets. In order to receive more tickets, you must return your numbered ticket stubs and money (**cash and checks made payable to All Saints Parish**) to the school office.
4. **Any sold and unsold tickets must be returned to the school no later than February 7, 2018**, so the totals can be validated and sent to the parish.
5. A school and a parish representative will be available at SJCS on Friday 1/12 from 2:00-5:00 pm for you to sign out your ticket booklet. At that time, you will be given a sales packet of information including: tickets, a handout with raffles rules, and a pin to wear that will advertise the raffle sale. We will also have a sign-up sheet for weekend Masses if your student wishes to help promote their ticket sales.
6. Please do not let your child go door to door for sales. We encourage parents and children to sell to their co-workers, family members, and to trusted community members. If you choose to use Facebook as a means to promote your students ticket sales, please make sure it is through the parent's Facebook account.
7. If you are unable to come Friday, tickets will available to sign out on January 16th at the school office during normal business hours. We encourage all students to participate and to move the tickets as quickly as possible!

8. ***Eighth grade students only** – If you are the top seller of raffle tickets, you will be given a \$5,000 scholarship to bring with you to the Catholic High School of your choice. If you win and are not attending a Catholic High School in the fall, your winnings will be designated as a scholarship in your name to a child in need at St. John’s Catholic School in the amount of \$5,000.
